Cradle Fundraiser

To benefit the Mooseheart/Moosehaven Endowment Fund

Hey folks, when you participate in the Cradle Fundraiser in October you are getting *endowment donations* from your members and those visiting your social quarters. **And, your Lodge gets credit towards its all giving!**

- Step 1:** Make copies of the paper Cradles
- Step 2:** **ASK** every member/guest to help your Lodge or Chapter raise money for the endowment fund
- Step 3:** Recognize the donors by posting the paper Cradles prominently in your Lodge home

Ideas/Suggestions:

- ✓ Lodge officers meet and agree to hold a friendly competition.
- ✓ Create a friendly challenge: Use different colored paper for the Cradles for each group in the challenge. Make a game out of who has the most colored Cradles on the way at the end of the month.
- ✓ “Work” the Cradle Fundraiser every day and every night through the end of October. **Use special dates or sport games or holidays to promote the fundraiser: Oktoberfest, Halloween, World Smile Day (Oct. 4), National Do Something Nice Day (Oct. 5), Sweetest Day (Oct. 19), National Make a Difference Day (Oct. 26), or make up a special day that’s meaningful or fun to those in your lodge.**
- ✓ Meal functions: Place paper Cradles at each table setting and/or provide a paper Cradle at the same time as providing liquid refreshments at a table or bar. If you’re doing drive-up food service or drive-up endowment collections have Cradles ready to promote.
- ✓ **Keep a running total, ring a bell, bang a gong, blow a horn, or do a happy dance when a donation is made!**
- ✓ **Post pictures on Facebook and show them throughout the month.**

IMPORTANT: All cash donations must be remitted to Moose Charities by a Lodge or Chapter check, payable to Moose Charities and **ear-marked “Cradle Fundraiser 2024”**.
Mail to: Moose Charities, 155 S. International Dr., Mooseheart, IL 60539, **postmarked by November 15th**.

Also, include any personal checks written to Moose Charities in the same envelope.
